### IV. Meeting

**A.** Mike Clancy, from the Mobile Crisis Response Team gave a presentation to the group about the services available through Mobile Crisis. The service is now able to be accessed by private citizens directly. Initially, police officers could only request Mobile Crisis Response. The goal is to stabilize mental health situations and avoid unnecessary trips to the ER.

**B. Surveys-**

An update was provided with preliminary results from the Community survey being used as part of the new CCLMB Needs Assessment.

**C. Training Dollars**

The CCLMB was awarded an FY 19 training grant in the amount of \$10,000. CCLMB members were asked to provide feedback regarding training ideas that would be useful to the community. Initial ideas are trauma, ACES and suicide. Ed Singer, from CCHD, will participate in the design of the training.

**D. Community Plan**

**A meeting to begin writing and designing the Community Plan, a requirement of the FY 20 GOC NOFA, will be held on November 29 at Citizen Services.**
