Plastic Bags (Bagged Together) May Be Returned To The Grocery Store

Drop off CFL bulbs at any Home Depot or Lowe's, or ask about CFL recycling at your local Ace Hardware. They are also accepted at Carroll County's Household Hazardous Waste Events.

Unacceptable Items:

Latex Paint1 Explosives/Ammunition Asbestos Medical Waste/Medicine2 Biohazard Waste Radioactive Materials Compressed Gas Tanks/Cylinders Rechargeable/Household Batteries Vehicle Batteries Motor Oil/ Antifreeze3

1. Latex paint can be disposed in regular trash after solidified by using an absorbent agent such as kitty litter, sand, mulch, shredded paper.

2. Unused and expired medication can be taken to the following police stations: Westminster, Taneytown, Sykesville, and N.E. Greenmount. They do not accept syringes.

3. Vehicle batteries, motor oil/antifreeze are accepted year round at our Northern Landfill Recycling Center 1400 Baltimore Blvd, Westminster, MD 21157. Monday - Friday, 7am-4:30pm, Saturday 7am-3pm.
