Carroll County, Maryland Historic Preservation Commission Mission Statement

The mission of the Commission is to oversee and preserve the historical, architectural, and archeological purity of the Historic District of Uniontown by hearing applications for construction, alterations, reconstruction, repairs, and moving or demolition of any properties within the Historic District Overlay, and applying the pertinent Zoning ordinances and local laws to the matters brought before them.

The responsibilities of the Board are to:

- Hold hearings for work permits and applications for exterior changes which would affect the historic accuracy of the properties.
- Consider the County zoning ordinances in reaching decisions on matters that come before the Board.
- Discuss County policies and procedures related to the Historic District.
- Make recommendations to the Board of Carroll County Commissioners concerning historic properties in Carroll County
- Maintain and update the Maryland Inventory of Historic Properties for Carroll County.
- Assist the citizens and County personnel of Carroll County in correctly interpreting the design requirements for the Uniontown Historic District.
