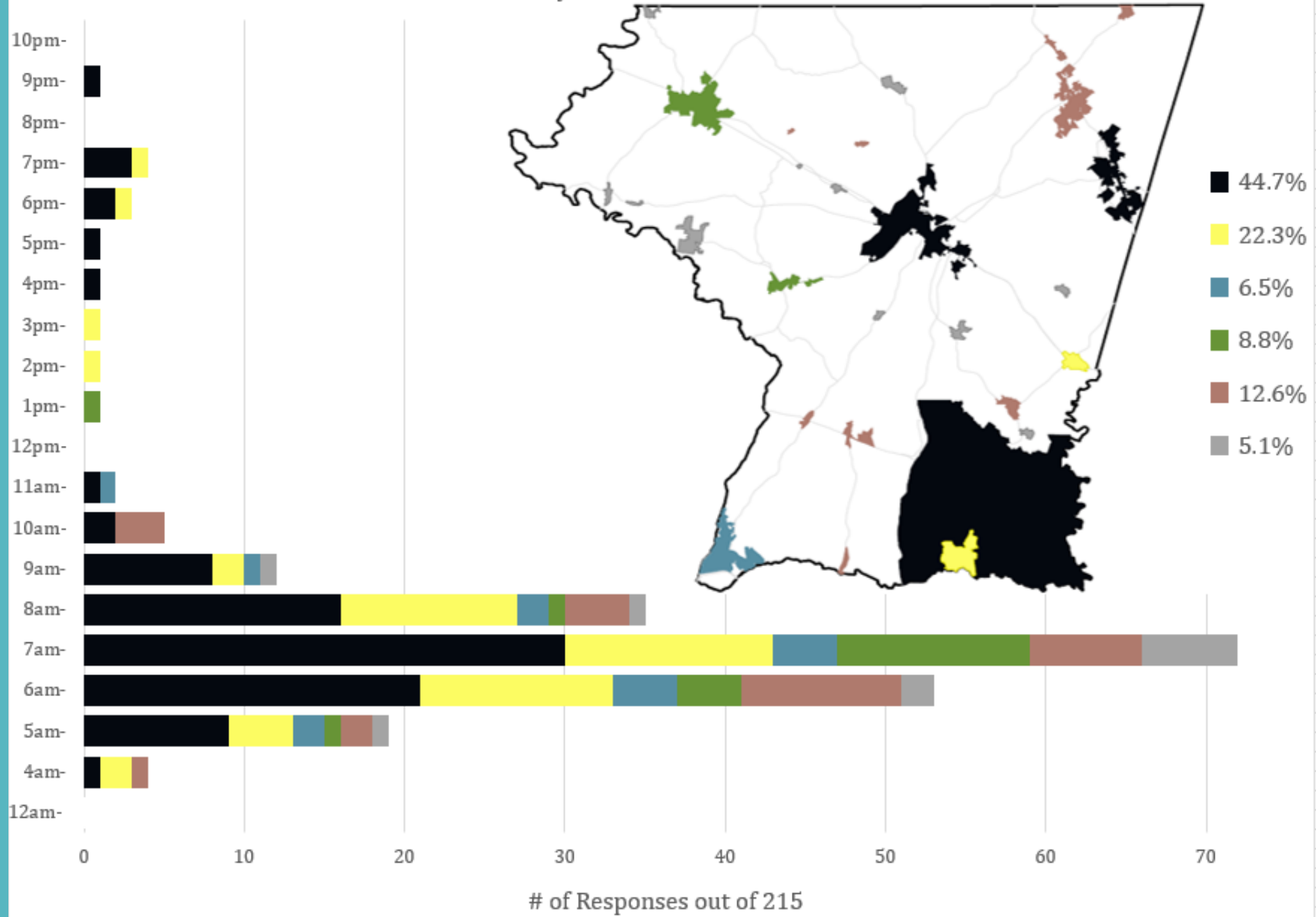

 - ❑ 198 (92%) live in Carroll County

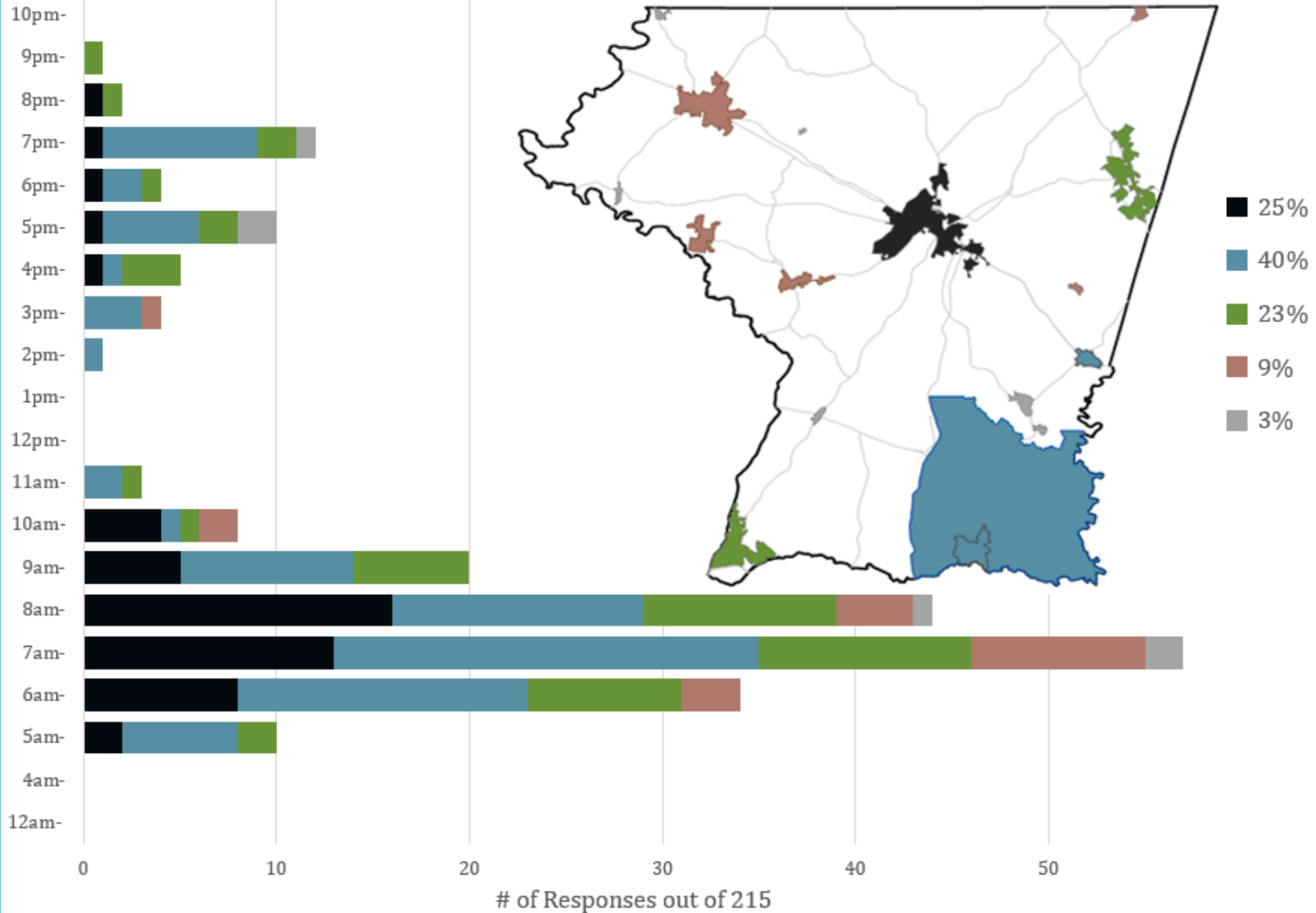
Location & Time Survey Respondents Begin Commuting in Carroll Co. by Percent and Number

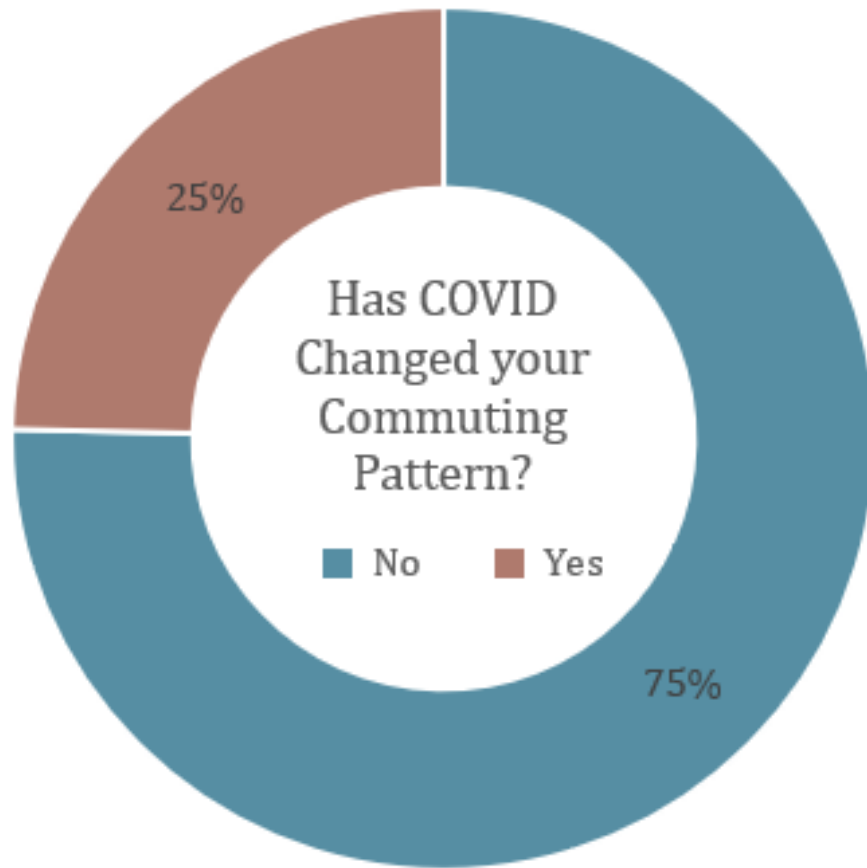

- 4% experienced a shift in their work schedule

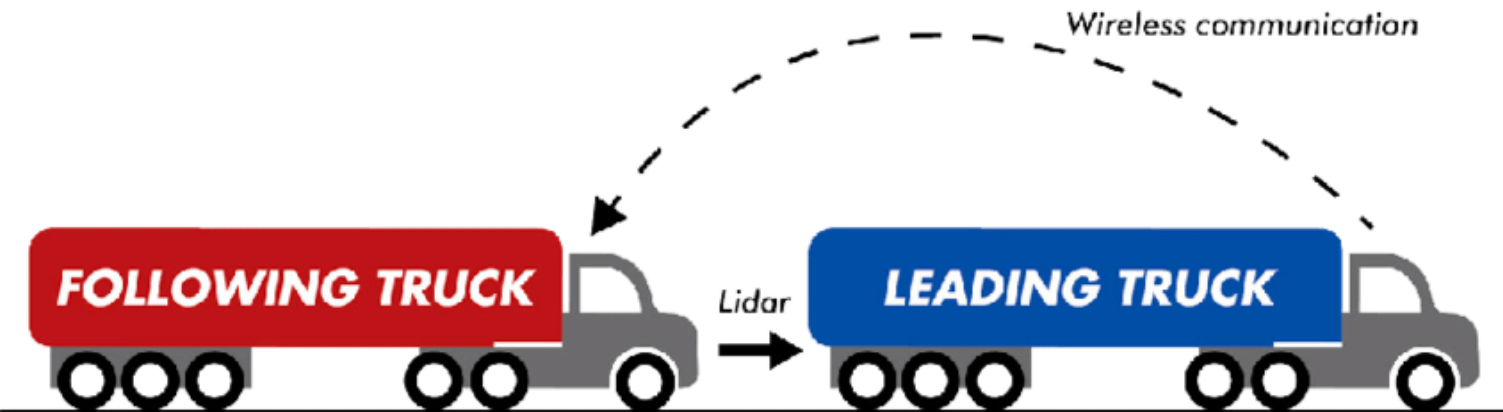
Platooning

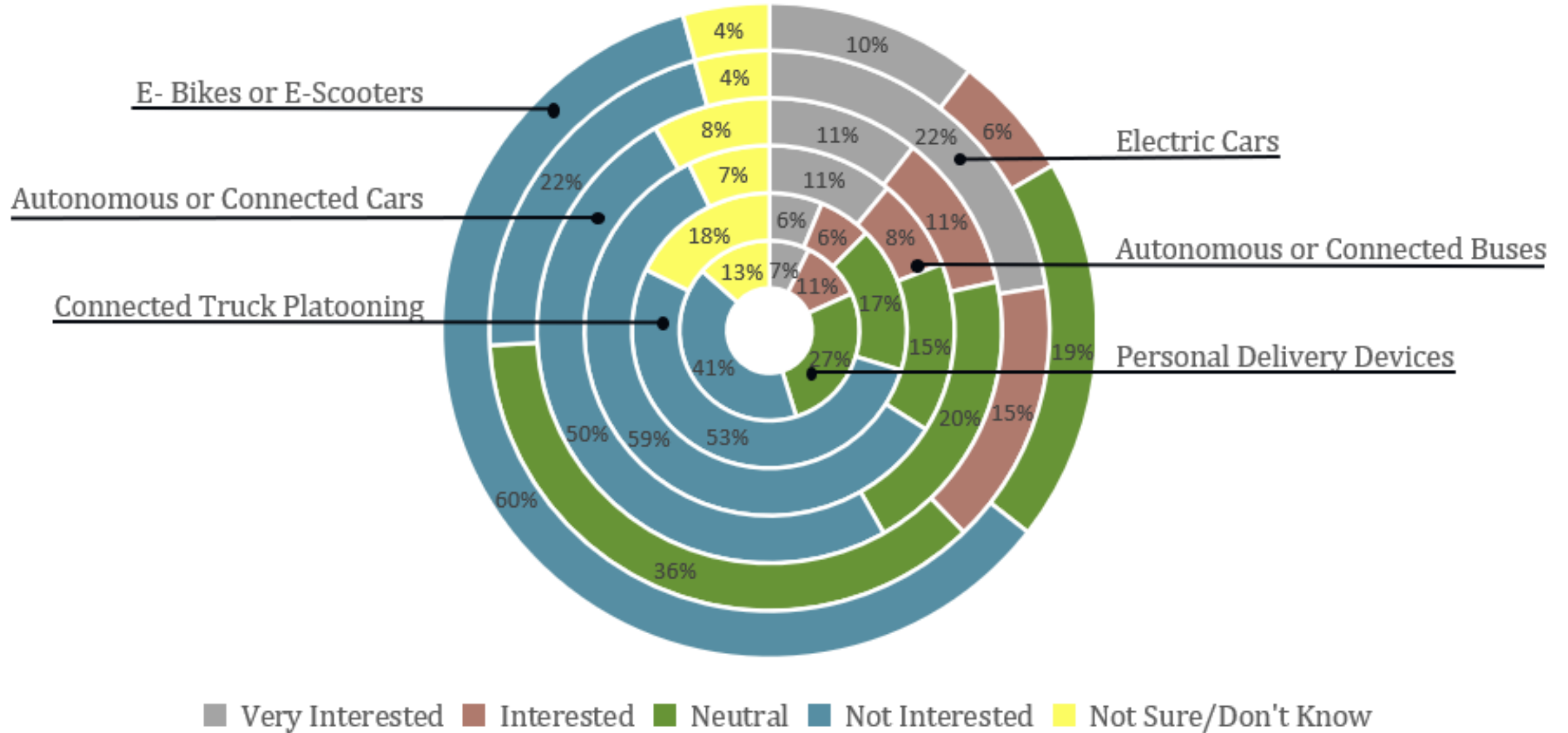
- Wirelessly communicates information on braking, speed, and oncoming obstacles

Personal Delivery Device

a powered device that is operated primarily on shoulders, sidewalks, and crosswalks, is intended for the transport of property on public rights-of-way weighs not more than 550 pounds, excluding cargo, and is capable of navigating with or without the active control or monitoring of an individual.
