## EMS Policies and Procedures

### I. PURPOSE

Carroll County Department of Fire and EMS shall maintain a Standardized EMS Inventory on all department response ready vehicles.

### II. DEFINITIONS

**Standardized Inventory:** An established amount and arrangement of equipment and supplies for a designated piece of apparatus.

**Primary Emergency Response Apparatus:** Any apparatus that would be dispatched to an incident where EMS service is anticipated. Typically, these are station based front line units such as Ambulances, Engines, Special Services, and Supervisor vehicles.

**Voluntary Ambulance Inspection Program (VAIP):** The MIEMSS biennial inspection program that establishes a state-wide standard inventory for EMS vehicles. Compliance with the program provides a certification for our apparatus which has fiscal, legal, and regulatory benefits.

**Durable Medical Equipment:** Medical equipment that is reusable and not disposed of after each call. Items such as monitors, backboards, traction splints, oxygen cylinders etc.

**EMS Supply Vending Machines:** The vending machine style EMS supply dispenser that is placed at Carroll Hospital Center and other strategically placed fire stations.

### III. PROCEDURES

- A. All operational personnel will check their assigned apparatus using the established Standardized EMS Inventories on a daily and weekly basis, at the beginning of each shift.
- B. A monthly inventory shall be completed by the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month and forwarded to the Shift Commander or designee. This report shall include:

- i. Replacement of stock that expires in the upcoming month. Items that have only the month and year as the expiration date expire at the end of the given month.
  - ii. Expiring stock is not to be replaced from any of the vending machines.
- C. Standardized EMS Inventories vary by apparatus type and response profile.
  - i. ALS Transport Units
    - a. All response ready ambulances equipped for the Advanced Life Support level patient care shall have following inventory items
      - 1. Advanced Life Support Bag (Attachment C)
      - 2. Pediatric Bag (Attachment A)
      - 3. Cardiac Monitor
      - 4. Oxygen / BLS Bag (Attachment B)
      - 5. ALS Ambulance Inventory
  - ii. BLS Transport Units
    - a. All response ready ambulances equipped for the Basic Life Support level patient care, shall have the following items.
      - 1. Oxygen/BLS Bag
      - 2. BLS Ambulance Inventory
  - iii. Suppression Units (Engines, Trucks, Towers, Squads etc.)
    - a. All response ready suppression apparatus will be stocked to a minimum of Basic Life Support level and shall carry the following items
      - 1. Oxygen/BLS Bag for suppression vehicles
      - 2. AED
    - b. Any response ready suppression apparatus that is staffed with an ALS Clinician and has equipment to perform Advanced Life Support shall be described in the Standardized EMS Inventory for Suppression Apparatus.
  - iv. EMS Chase Cars (Career)
    - a. Stocked for ALS level of care with the addition of specialty care items and limited supplies for restocking of transport units, shall have the following items
      - 1. Advanced Life Support Bag
      - 2. Pediatric Bag
      - 3. Oxygen/BLS Bag
      - 4. Cardiac Monitor
      - 5. Additional restock items
  - v. EMS Chase Cars (Volunteer)
    - a. Stocked for ALS level care, with the following items
      - 1. Advanced Life Support Bag
      - 2. Pediatric Bag
      - 3. Oxygen/BLS Bag
      - 4. Cardiac Monitor
  - vi. Command Staff and First Responder Vehicles
    - a. These vehicles shall be stocked to the BLS level of care at the Suppression Unit inventory. These vehicles may be stocked for ALS care as needed but are not intended for prolonged patient care. These

- vehicles will need the approval of the Chief of Fire and EMS to be stocked at the ALS level and will follow the Chase car Inventory
- vii. All Standardized EMS Inventory lists shall be posted on the Department of Fire and EMS web site along with CCVESA web site.

D. Inventory Checks and Accountability

- i. Daily checks shall be completed at the beginning of each shift. This check shall ensure that all equipment is functioning properly and that supplies match the inventory list.
- ii. Weekly checks shall be completed on the assigned day. These checks shall ensure that all equipment is functioning properly and that all supplies are in accordance with the Standardized EMS Inventories. During the weekly check, a Standardized EMS Inventory check sheet shall be completed and forwarded to the appropriate battalion EMS Chase Car.
- iii. Monthly checks shall be completed on the last weekly of the month. This check shall include noting all supplies that expire in the coming month. The Monthly check sheet shall also be forwarded to the EMS Chase Car to ensure all expiring supplies can be restocked prior to the end of the month.

E. Sealed EMS Bags and/or Compartments

- i. It is an acceptable practice to seal EMS bags and/or compartments provided a numerical tag is used. This number shall be documented on the daily check sheet to verify contents are correct.
- ii. If the seal is broken, the entire contents shall be inventoried, and a new seal placed on the EMS bag and/or compartment.
- iii. All sealed items will be opened during the monthly check and inventoried with expiration dates verified.

F. Changes to Standardized EMS Inventories

- i. All changes must be approved by the Assistant Chief of EMS and the Medical Director.
- ii. Request for changes must be submitted to the Assistant Chief of EMS through the chain of command for review and processing.
- iii. All request for changes must be submitted on the "Request for Change Form."
- iv. Standardized EMS Inventories are designed to enhance clinicians' abilities to provide care. Provider input and change requests are strongly encouraged to further enhance the capabilities of all personnel.

IV. RECISION

This Standard Operating Procedure rescinds all directives regarding Standardized EMS Inventories or similar content previously issued for personnel of the Carroll County Department of Fire and EMS.
