Narcotic Replacement and Changes to Minimum Quantities

Effective immediately, all narcotic replacement shall be completed through the Shift Commander or the EMS Chase Cars. This shall include the expiration of any medication listed. Each EMS car will maintain an adequate supply of Fentanyl, Midazolam, and Ketorolac to replace any used medications on transport units or any allocated ALS unit. The Shift Commander can be reached via radio or through their office phone at 410-386-6813. The office phone will be automatically forwarded to the Shift Commander's cell phone in the event they are not in quarters. The EMS chase cars can be reached by radio or by contacting the station in which they are assigned.

With the increased availability for a timely restock we are also reducing the amount of medication carried on each transport unit and ALS unit countywide. The following are the new minimum and maximum standards:

Medication	Minimum	Maximum
Fentanyl	400 mcg	500 mcg
Midazolam	20 mg	25 mg
Ketorolac	30 mg	60 mg
